Dear Colleagues,

Following the First Circular distributed on 23 January 2026, we are pleased to announce that the [official EurBee 11 website is now online](#) and that abstract submissions and registrations are open.

EurBee 11 will take place in Bologna, Italy, from 7 to 10 September 2026. The venue is the [Bologna Congress Centre](#) (you may want to [click here for a virtual tour](#)).

The Local Organising Committee has worked to define the following details, which you are welcome to consider.

Scientific topics

To reflect the recent developments in bee science, EurBee 11 adopts eleven cross-cutting topics, thought to be suitable for contributions on both managed and wild bees. The topics are listed [here](#), along with the contribution subjects that may fit into each one of them.

Submissions

Abstracts can be submitted after a short pre-registration procedure via the [EurBee 11 website](#) or directly through this [link](#). Submission deadline is on 20 March 2026.

All submissions will be evaluated by the Scientific Board. Acceptance will require confirmation through payment of the registration fee within the specified deadlines (see Important Dates below).

Registration Fees

We made significant efforts to keep fees as low as possible. Reduced rates are available for students, early-bird registrations, and participants electing to be EurBee members. The [system](#) also allows payment of the EurBee membership fee alone for those who wish to join without attending the Conference.

Only current fees are shown, which will be modified once the early bird registration deadline has passed. Late registrations will incur an extra administrative charge of 130 €.

The choice to become a EurBee member entails a slightly lower registration fee.

If you registered as a student, please be prepared to provide official proof of your status upon request.

What the Registration fees include

Registered participants will have access to all scientific activities, including oral and poster sessions. Fees cover coffee breaks and light lunches during the Conference. Participation in a guided tour, the opening ceremony with a buffet, the closing ceremony, and the gala dinner is also included.
